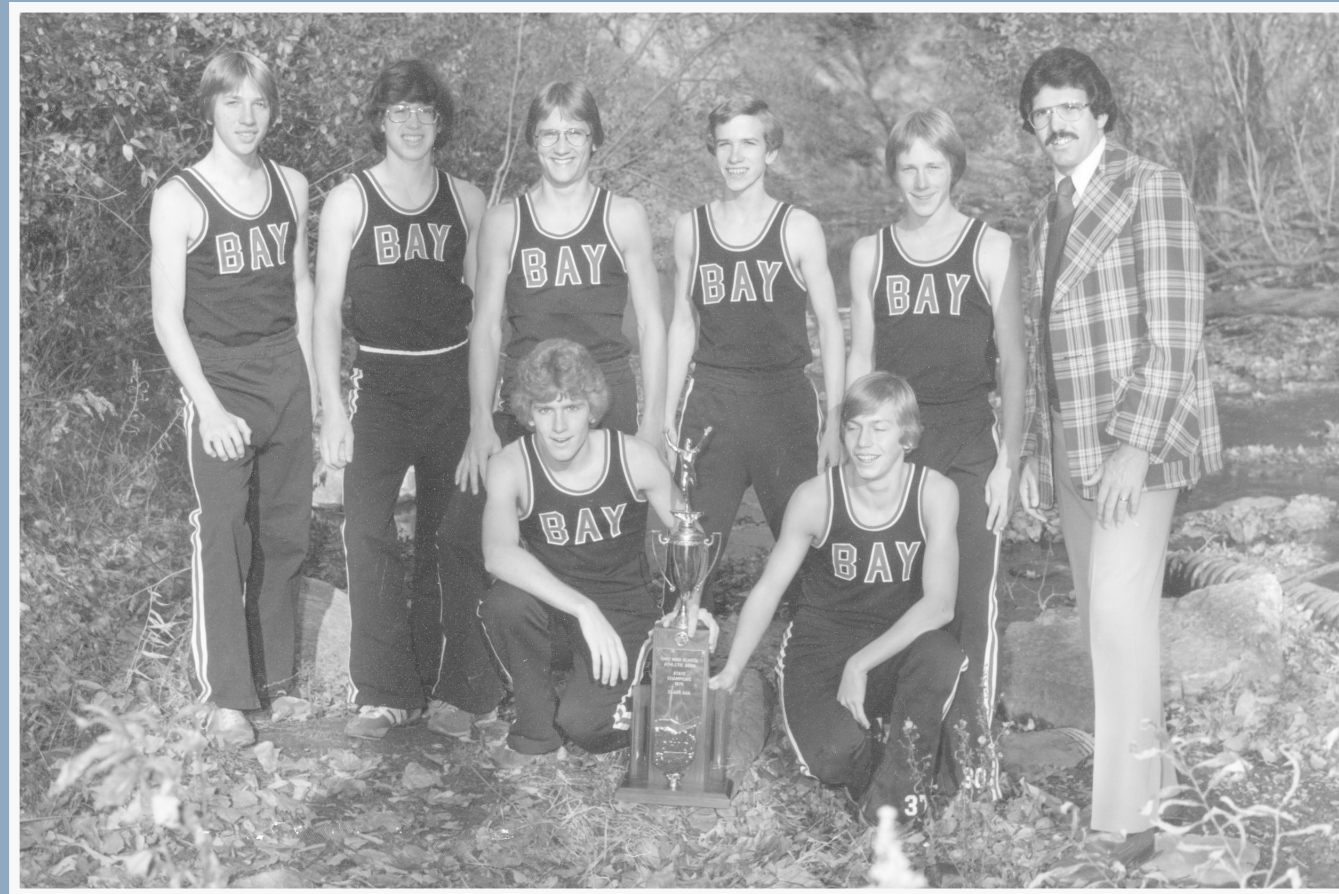

Bay High Boys Cross-Country Team 1976

Won the Ohio State Cross-Country Team Championship in AAA (Division I)

Ranked as the fifth best high school cross-country team in the U.S. by Harrier Magazine.

Won five major cross-country invitationals for a combined record of 102 wins and 0 losses.

Undefeated in dual meets versus Southwest Conference opponents for a record of 7 wins and 0 losses.

Won the Southwest cross-country championship with five runners finishing in the top six.

Five runners received Division I college scholarships in cross-country and a sixth ran in a Division III program.

Five runners on the team were All-Ohio and one was a High School All-American

Won Sectional and District cross-country championships.

All seven runners ran under 10:00 minutes for 2 miles and under 4:30 for the mile.
